Notes

- Guideline positions are based, to a large degree, on survey work by Andreas Hagberg, Kyle Harmon and Kirill Egorov (thanks guys!). Be sure to check out Andreas' breathtaking photography on Facebook.
- Distances are in feet, but may not be perfectly to scale.
- Depths can fluctuate with water level. In general, however, the guideline is seldom deeper than 10 m/33 ft. Depths at the top of the debris cone can be half this.
- Compass headings are magnetic; however, in north-central Florida, compass variance from true north is generally less than one degree.
